## The DELF Prim

The DELF Prim is a French Language Studies diploma issued by the French Ministry of Education and administrated by the Centre international d'études pédagogiques (CIEP), a department of this Ministry.

It is designed for children at the elementary school level.

The DELF Prim is divided into three levels:

A1.1,A1 and A2 and corresponds to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).



## The exam

The test, conducted in a group setting and using an attractive activity book format, includes themes from a child's environment, such as their family, hobbies and school.

The child answers the following type of questions in the activity booklet:



Oral comprehension questions: Understanding a simple instruction, an order, a description, numbers.



Written comprehension questions: Understanding a simple instruction, a short text, a message or a postcard.



Written expression questions: Writing about themselves, completing a simple message or story



The child also participates in an individual oral assessment (15 minutes maximum). He or she is invited to speak about herself or himself, to tell a story based on pictures and/or to take part in a role play dialogue.


